

A NOTE FROM OUR BOARD

It is now early February, and we are very close to having all the Impression Homes sold out! I know that will be nice for everyone.

The Board has a few items of interest to bring to your attention. Please watch out for two key items.

ENHANCED ELECTION PROCEDURES - We have enhanced the election procedures to make the election process as transparent as possible and to provide guidelines for voters as well as for those who want to serve on the Board. You can review that document on line. It is part of the Rules and Regulations Compilation, located in the "Important Information" section of the HOA website. It starts on page 79. The HOA attorneys have reviewed the documents and confirm that they are compliant with all HOA rules and regulations as well as any applicable Texas state laws. <u>A comment period has been set by the Board. You should receive</u> <u>information from Classic regarding the open comment period for this</u> <u>document. Once the comment period closes, closed, the document will be</u> <u>voted on by the Board. Please use this opportunity to provide input.</u>

BYLAW UPDATE TO ALLOW MEETINGS CLOSER TO HOME - In addition, the Board will be asking you to vote to approve a change to our HOA bylaws. Currently, our bylaws only allow us to hold regular meetings in Tarrant County. This can be cumbersome, and we would like to be able to hold meetings in Dallas County as well. Approval would allow us to hold meetings on site, for instance. You should be receiving that information in the US mail and by email soon. **Please encourage your neighbors to vote! We need 2/3rds of home owners to affirm this change in order for it to go into effect.**

Unfortunately, our bylaws have a separate clause that require **us** to hold our annual Board election meetings in Tarrant county as well. To change this would require a different vote by owners, and it may be addressed in the future. In the meantime, <u>we are locating a meeting place closer by</u> our neighborhood for that annual Board meeting. The vote for Board members typically happens in early May.

And finally, yes, we are working on the problem with the trash cans at both post office box locations, as well as putting into place some method to ensure that the streetlight bulbs are replaced soon after they burn out.
